As Nestle Purina PetCare Company, we represent the pet food Strategic Business Unit (SBU) of Nestle USA. Other divisions of Nestle USA include the following: Beverage, Confections and Snacks, Food Services, Foreign Trade, Nutrition, Prepared Foods, Ice Cream, and Waters.

Career Tracks and Advancement

We are currently recruiting for several Management Trainee positions in Accounting. Visit our booth during the Career Fair to discuss these exciting opportunities. These are full time positions with an established career track.

Management Trainees typically are Trainees for one year. They train in both our Dry and Wet pet food plants, and are required to document their training in a “Training Report” which is due approximately six (6) months after their hire date. After the initial training, the Trainee goes through further training in his/her respective department. Trainees are then promoted to an Assistant, and it’s during this time frame that they may be transferred to another Nestlé plant depending on the openings available in the Division. If they are not transferred at that time, their training continues at the plant they started their training.

Work Environment

We are a 24-hr, 3-shift manufacturing operation.

Dress Code

The Dress Code at Nestlé Purina is Business Casual. Jeans are permitted on Fridays and also if employees are spending a great deal of time in the plant.

Tuition Reimbursement

Full-time employees receive 100% reimbursement up to \$2,500, then 50% reimbursement of the remaining eligible expenses per calendar year.

Reimbursement is made after successful completion of the course. Tuition is not advanced prior to course completion.

Educational reimbursement is reduced by scholarships or Veteran agency-type reimbursements.

Must earn a grade of “B” or better for graduate work. (B- does not qualify).
