Zotero

- **Zotero**¹ is a FREE and open-source reference management software to manage bibliographic data and related research materials (such as PDF files). Notable features include:
 - 1 Bibliographies
 - 2 Web browser integration (I personally use Chrome...)
 - 3 Library share
 - 4 Annotation in PDF² (An additional installation needed)
 - 5 Footnotes
