Criteria:

- Female Identifying Students (US based)
- In their first year (freshman year) of 4 year under-graduate program
- With a demonstrable interest in the Financial Services industry shown via an essay (length 500 words)
- Who can provide 2 letters of recommendation (one academic; one personal)
- Grade Point Average (GPA) to be provided (Aegon AM will apply a screen depending on response rate)

Application process:

Applicant must submit the following items:

- 1. Completed Application form (if handwritten, please print legibly)
- 2. Two (2) letters of recommendations
 - a. One academic from choice of former high school teacher, college professor, administrators, counselors
 - b. One personal from an individual with significant knowledge of applicants experience and involvement (not a family member. Ideally someone within the community).
- 3. An official and recent high school transcript with cumulative grade point average
- 4. Two Essays (500 words each)
 - a. Please describe your personal accomplishments to earn this scholarship and the impact of this award on your future
 - b. Your interest in the Financial Services Industry (feel free to discuss your chosen major/minor in related discipline)
